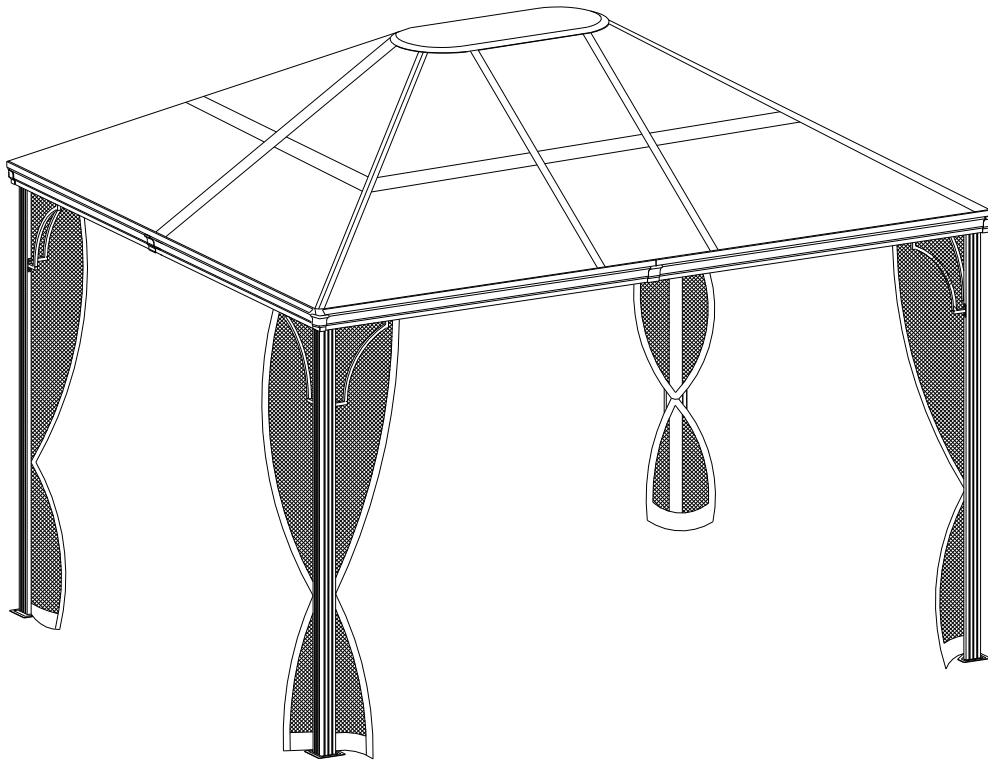

- ☐ Some parts may contain sharp edges, wear protective gloves if necessary. At least three or more people are recommended for safe assembly.
- ☐ Keep all children and pets away from assembly area.
- ☐ Begin assembly not less than 6 feet from any obstruction such as fence, garage, house, overhanging branches, laundry line or electrical wires.
- ☐ Install on level ground. This gazebo cannot be permanently staked or attached to concrete floor or platform. The provided stakes are for soft ground use only. If assembling on a hard surface like a deck or concrete, other forms of attachment must be used such as expansion bolts that can be purchased locally.
- ☐ This gazebo is intended for decorative and sunshade purposes only and is not meant to withstand inclement weather including high winds, rain and snow. Polycarbonate roof is water resistant, not water proof and may leak during exposure to precipitation.
- ☐ Please lay out all parts before assembling, checking to make sure all parts are there. If any parts are missing, please call 1-866-578-6569 and parts will be expedited to you.
- ☐ KEEP ALL FLAME AND HEAT SOURCES AWAY FROM THIS TENT FABRIC. This Tent meets the flammability requirements of CPAI - 84. The fabric may burn if left in continuous contact with any flame source. The application of any foreign substance to the tent fabric may render the flame-resistant properties ineffective.
- ☐ **The roof of unit can withstand up to 600 lbs of snow accumulation. Please sweep the snow in time when the snow depth is more than 10inch.**
- ☐ The PC board has UV protection coating, and the UV resistant is 2500h.

Limited Warranty

The item is warranted to be free from defects in frame & finish for a period of 5 years and Polycarbonate panel for a period of 2 years. However, we don't reimburse for transportation or delivery costs, or compensate the individual or any outside party for assembling or disassembling the product. This limited warranty is extended to the original purchaser and applies to defects in materials and workmanship of your item, provided the item is maintained with care and used only for personal, residential purposes.

Exclusions:

It remains the customer's responsibility for freight and packaging charges to and from our service center. Items used for commercial, contract, or other non-residential purposes, or items damaged due to acts of nature, vandalism, misuse, or improper assembly are not covered. Corrosion or rusting of hardware is not covered. Proof of purchase (dated register receipt) is required for warranty claims. Warranty is to the original purchaser and is non-transferable. Any replacement of warranted items will be in the original style and color, or a similar style and color if the original is unavailable or has been discontinued. As some states do not allow exclusions or limitations on an implied warranty, the above exclusions and limitations may not apply. This warranty gives you specific rights, and you may also have other rights, which vary from state to state.

Care and Maintenance

It is advised that the polycarbonate roof should be removed in the winter for best protection and length of use. Our steel components for garden accessories and furniture are treated with rust inhibiting paint that protects them from rusting. However, due to the nature of steel, surface oxidation (rusting) will occur once these protective coatings are scratched. This is a natural process and is not a defect! To minimize this condition, we recommend care when assembling & handling the product

to prevent scratching the paint. Should any scratching or damage occur, it is strongly recommended that consumers buy touch up paint prior to the assembly process so that any parts they scratch during assembly are touched up. Surface rust can also be easily removed with a very light application of common cooking oil. If surface oxidation (rusting) occurs and if no measure is taken to prevent this, the oxidation may start dripping on to deck or patio and cause damaging stains, which may be difficult to remove. This can be prevented if the measure is taken to keep the product from oxidizing. Also the use of wax candle to lubricate the zippers once a year will keep them running smoothly.







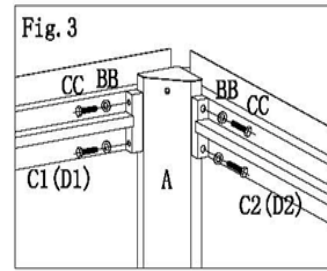
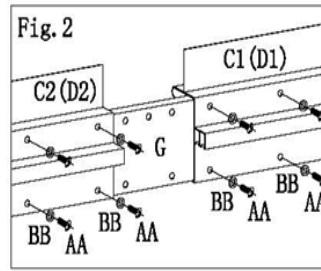
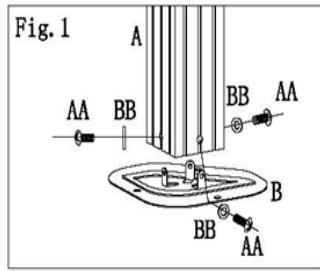


Fig.1: Attach Stake Slice (B) on Post (A) and fix them tightly by Bolt (AA) and Flat Washer (BB).

Fig.2: Attach Decorative Groove Connector (G) to Decorative Grooves (C1&C2&D1&D2) and fix them tightly by Bolt (AA) and Flat Washer (BB).

Fig.3: Attach Post (A) to Decorative Grooves (C1&C2&D1&D2) and fix them tightly by Bolt (CC) and Flat Washer (BB).

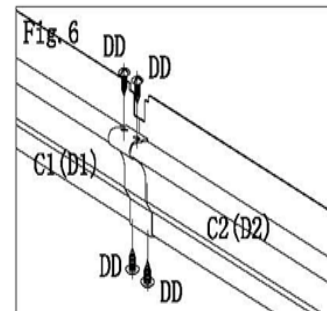
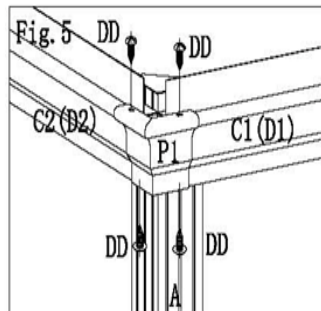
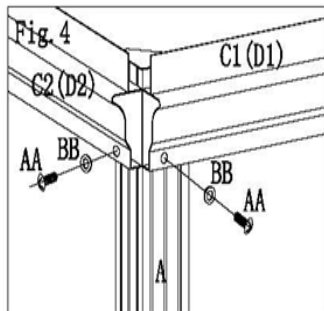


Fig.4: Attach Decorative Grooves (C1&C2&D1&D2) to Post (A) from the outside and fix them tightly by Bolt (AA) and Flat Washer (BB).

Fig.5: Attach the lower side of corner cover (P1) to decorative grooves (C1, C2 , D1 & D2) using screw (DD)., and fix the up side using screw (DD).

Fig.6: Attach the lower side of corner cover (P2) to decorative grooves (C1, C2, D1 & D2) using screw (DD), and fix the up side using screw (DD).

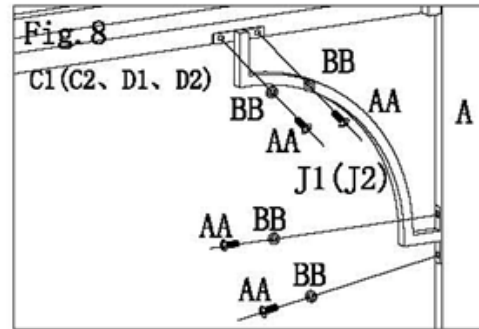
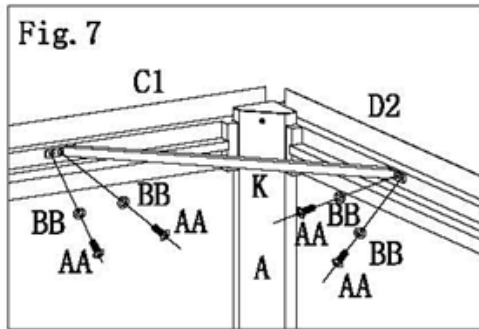




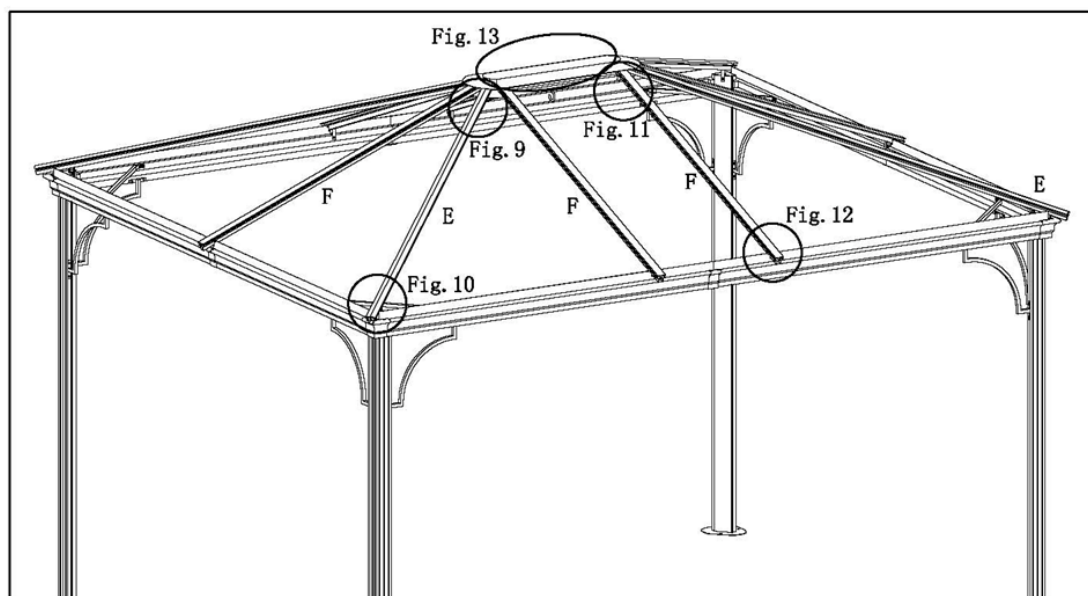
Fig.7: Use Bolt (AA) and Flat Washer (BB) to lock Corner Support (K) to Short Decorative Groove 1(D2) and Long Decorative Groove 2 (C1).

Fig.8: Use Bolt (AA) and Flat Washer (BB) to lock Left Arc Support Bar (J1) and Right Arc Support Bar (J2) to Long Decorative Groove 1&2 (C1&C2), Short Decorative Groove 1&2 (D1&D2) and Post (A).

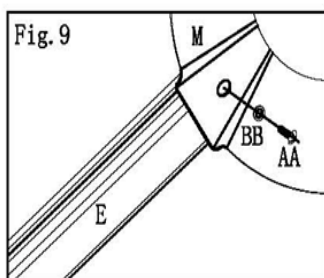


Fig.9: Use Bolt (AA) and Flat Washer (BB) to lock Corner Beam (E) to Roof Connector (M).

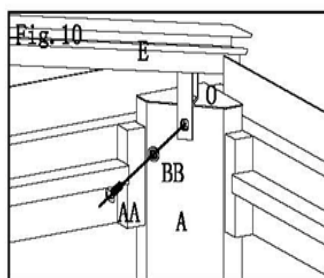


Fig.10: Firstly to put Post Up Connect Piece (O) on the top of the Post (A), then use Bolt (AA) and Flat Washer (BB) to lock the bottom of Corner Beam (E), Post (A) and Post Up Connect Piece (O) together. Lock them tightly.

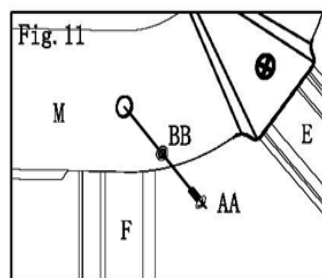


Fig.11: Use Bolt (AA) and Flat Washer (BB) to lock Middle Beam (F) to Roof Connector (M).

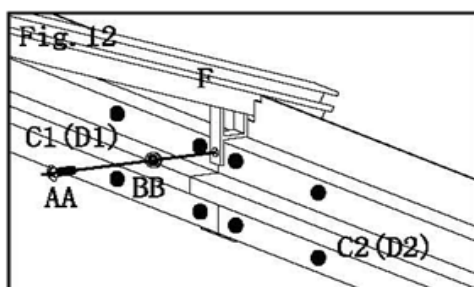


Fig.12: Use Bolt (AA) and Flat Washer (BB) to lock the bottom of the Middle Beam (F) to the Long Decorative Groove 1&2 (C1&C2) and Short Decorative Groove 1&2 (D1&D2).

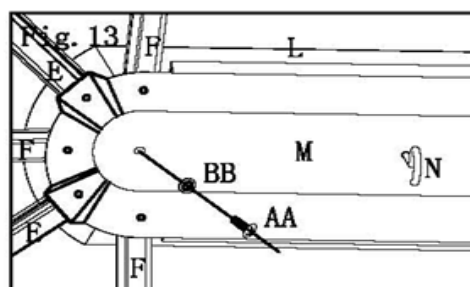




Fig.13: Put Small Roof Cover (L) on Roof Connector (M) firstly, use Bolt (AA) and Flat Washer (BB) to lock tightly. Then assemble Hook (N) to the Roof Connector (M).

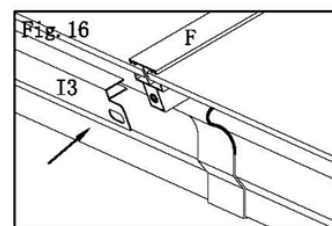
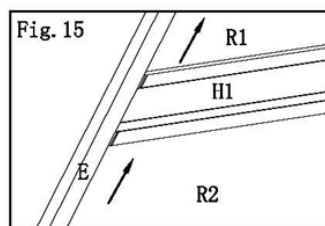
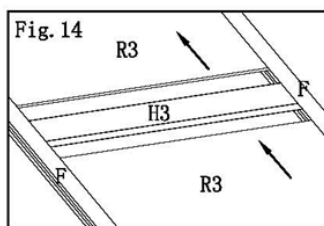
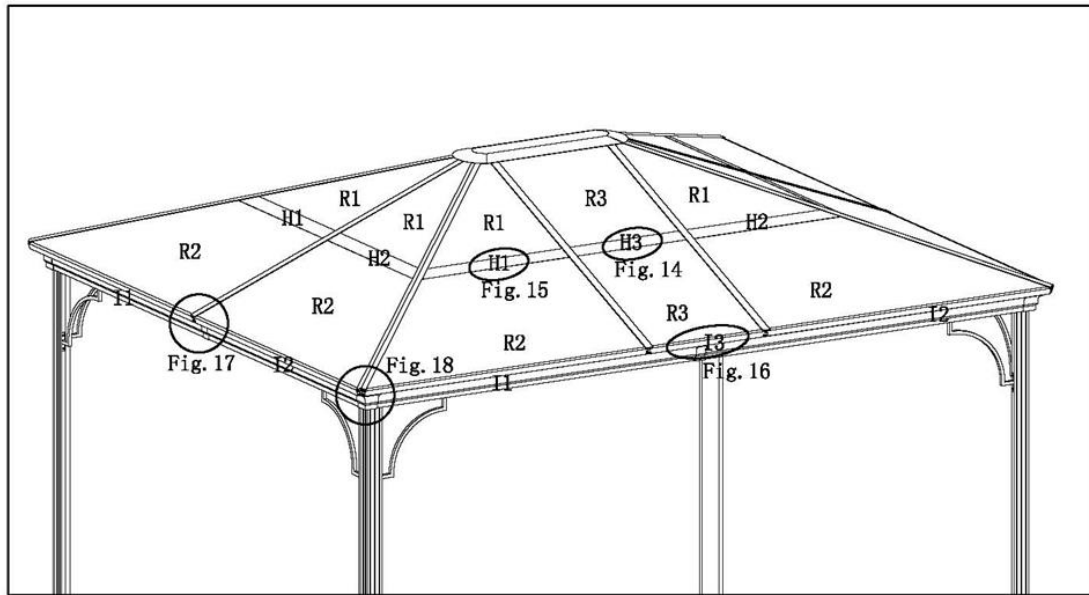


Fig.14: Insert PC Board 3 (R3) into the Gazebo Top, and then insert Middle Slot (H3) and another PC Board 3 (R3) into the Gazebo Top.

(Note: “on” side is upper side)

Fig.15: Insert PC Board 1 (R1) into the Gazebo Top, and then insert Middle Slot (H1) and another PC Board 2 (R2) into the Gazebo Top.
(Note: “on” side is upper side)

Fig.16: Cover the bottom of PC Boards with “F” Baffle (I3). (Insert “F” Baffle (I1&I2) in the same way, make sense of left and right.)

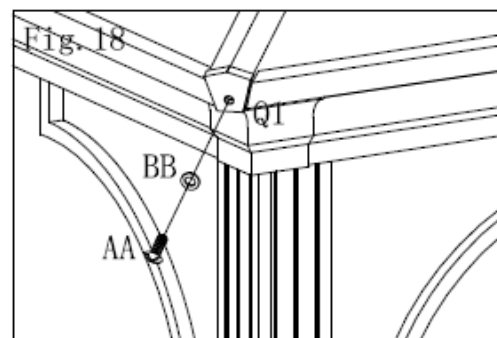
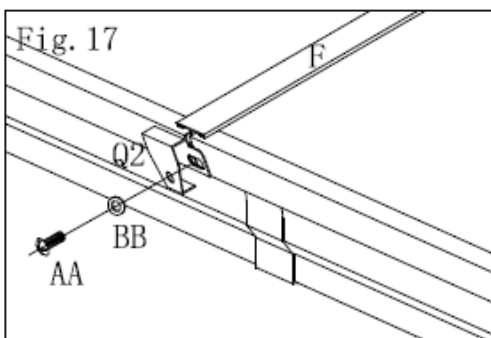



Fig.17: Insert Middle Closure plate (Q2) into the bottom of Middle Beam (F) by Bolt (AA) and washer (BB)

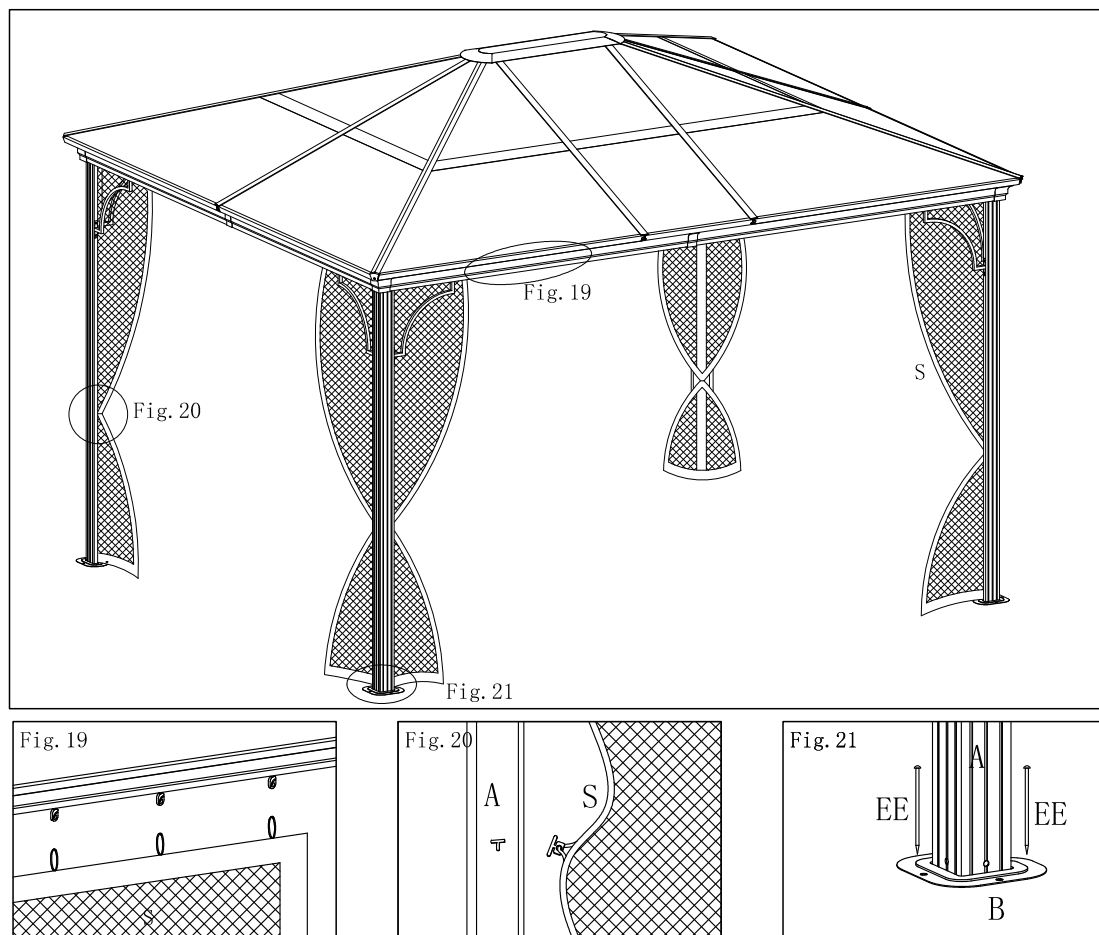


Fig.19: Use Hook (N) to attach the mosquito netting (S) to the netting tube.
