


JOSEPHINE DUO PANEL Model #1544-670 King Duo Panel

Examine all packaging material for small parts that may have come loose during shipment. Periodic checks are recommended to insure that all components are in proper position, tight and free from damage. Keep this assembly instruction for future reference. Adult assembly is required. STEP 1 - Figure 1 - If using Panel as Headboard

Begin assembly by inserting each Plastic Plug (H) into the bottom of each Leg Extension (K) by screwing in place. Attach each Leg Extension (K) into the bottom of each post on the Duo Panel (J) by fitting in place and aligning the holes on the backside. Once in place, secure each extension using 2 Allen Bolts (A) & 2 Flat Washers (D). Tighten all bolts using the Allen Wrench (G) that has been provided.

STEP 2 - Figure 2 - If using Panel as Headboard

Assemble the bed frame (*Not Included) to each Leg Extension (K) from the back using 2 Allen Bolts (C), and from the inside with 2 Flat Washers (D) & 2 Hex Nuts (E). Tighten all bolts and nuts using the hardware (F & G) provided. The assembly of your Headboard Duo Panel is complete. It is recommended that you keep any remaining parts and instruction sheet for future reference.

STEP 3 - Figure 3 - If using Panel as Footboard

Do not assemble Leg Extensions (K) to posts on Duo Panel (J). Begin assembly by inserting each Plastic Plug (H) into the bottom of each post on the Duo Panel (J) by screwing in place. Assemble the bed frame (Not Included) to each post using 2 Allen Bolts (B) & 2 Flat Washers (D). Tighten all bolts using the Allen Wrench (G) that has been provided. The assembly of your Footboard Duo Panel is complete. It is recommended that you keep any remaining parts and instruction sheet for future reference.

CARE & MAINTENANCE: The touch of a soft cloth is all the maintenance the finish will ever need. Please do not use harsh or abrasive cleaners for polishing, as they may cause damage to the finish. Periodic checks are recommended to make sure that all hardware is securely tightened.
