To keep your snow thrower in top condition year-round, follow these **CARE & MAINTENANCE TIPS** 

### START OF EACH SEASON:

- Change the oil
- Change the spark plug

#### FREQUENTLY FOR SUSTAINED **PERFORMANCE:**

- Check oil level / top off as needed
- Tighten/replace loose or missing hardware
- Clean off unit

#### **CONTINUALLY FOR MAXIMUM PERFORMANCE:**

- Check spark plug
- Lube control linkages and pivots
- Lube wheels with auto grease
- Lube gear and auger shafts
- Check chute control cable for slack

## **BEFORE YEARLY STORAGE:**

• Run engine until all fuel is gone
