
Caring for Your Game Table:


Keep the table free from dust. To remove dust use a lightly dampened, lint free towel. Wipe from the center of the table surface to the edge of the table as you clean.

Do not put wet objects such as drinks on the playing surface or any other part of the table as it might cause damage to the table.

Do not store in a damp place.

Do not place heavy objects on the playing surface.










STEP 2:


• Attach the four Leg assemblies to the table (#1) using four Bolts (#47), eight Washers (#48) per leg assembly. See Fig. 2A.




STEP 2:

- Hold two Leg Panels -Right and Left (#2 and #3). See Fig.1.
- Slide one Leg Panel Corner (#8) between the Leg Panels (#2and #3). See Fig.1A.
- Turn over the Leg assembly and then attach two Screws (#53) to the top of the middle of the Leg assembly. See Fig.1B.
- Attach four Leg Bases (#4) to Leg assemblies using four Screws (#51) per Leg Base. See Fig.1C
- Repeat the above steps for the other Leg Panels (#2 and #3) Corners (#8) and Leg Base (#4).








STEP 3:

- Attach four Leg Inside Panels (#5) to the Leg assemblies using six Screws (#52) per Leg Inside Panel. See Fig. 3A.
- [4] Attach the Goal Boxes (#19) to the Cabinet (#1) using two Screws (#53) per Goal Box. See Fig. 3B.
- Attach two Leg End Panels (#6) and two Leg Side Panels (#7) between two Legs using four Bolts (#49) with four washer (#50) per Leg End Panel and Side Panel.
- Screw four Leg Levelers (#18) into the four Legs. See Fig.3.
- You will need 4 or more adults for this step. Carefully lift the assembly off the floor and turn it over.
 CAUTION: Make sure that you place the table squarely onto its legs or damage to the table may occur.





STEP 4:

- Connect the wires under the table as shown above.
- WARNING! Do not mix old and new batteries. Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon zinc), or rechargeable (nickel cadmium) batteries. Do not dispose of batteries in fire, batteries may explode or leak.

NOTE: Please clean the battery contacts of the device prior to battery installation. Make sure to remove batteries from the scorer when not used for an extended period of time. Remove used batteries promptly.

ELECTRONIC SCORER OPERATION:

- 1. From underneath the table, unscrew the bolt using a screwdriver and open the battery box. Insert 4 AA batteries (not included) in the order of polarity as shown on the inside cover. Then close using a screwdriver. Turn on the power by turn the on/off switch on the battery box. (If the game will not be used for a long period of the time, we recommend that the batteries be removed.)
- 2. Turn on the scorer using the on/off switch on the control box. You will hear music and Home and Visitor will display "SC".
- There is one pre-set period of 5 minutes which can be adjusted to 10 minutes, 15 minutes, or "Free play" mode by pressing the "TIME/ RESET" button.
- 4. Press the "START/PAUSE" button to begin the game.
- During Play When the "TIME/RESET" button is pushed and held for 3 seconds, or after the game is over - when the "TIME/RESET" button is pushed, the scoreboard will reset back to the game time selection.
- Press the "START/PAUSE" button to Pause the game, to resume play, press this button again.
- 7. "Sound ON/OFF" Press this button while the game is on to turn the sound OFF and ON.
- Once the home or visitor has reached 99 points, the Home or Visitor display will stop scoring and flash continuously. Press the "TIME/ RESET" button to reset.
- 9. NOTE: If there is no score or any button pressed for 20 minutes, the scoreboard will automatically turn off. To restart press the "START/PAUSE" button. We suggest turning the power off when the game will not be used for an extended period of time.

HOCKEY GAME RULES:

- 1) This game is designed to be played with two (2) players, one at each end, or with four (4) players, two at each end of the game table.
- 2) Flip a coin to determine who will begin play, or a face-off can be held at the center of the table.
- Play begins when the puck is placed on the playing surface. Players must hit the puck with the hand-held pushers and attempt to shoot into the opponent's goal.
- 4) One point is awarded when a puck is shot into the opponent's goal.
- 5) Winning the game: the winning score is accomplished by being the first player to reach a predetermined score or by being the player to score the most points within a given period of time.
