

OILED LEATHERS

- Remove dirt from the shoe by cleaning thoroughly with a stiff bristle brush.
- Scrub gently with Red Wing Shoes Leather Cleaner, and then wipe off the cleaner and dirt with a clean cloth. Boots should then be dried naturally in a cool, dry place, as high heat can remove oils in the leather.
- Using leather cleaner reduces the oil in the leather. To re-add oil to the leather applies Red Wing Shoes Boot Oil or Mink Oil as directed.
