Assembly Instruction

1 Attaching the table legs

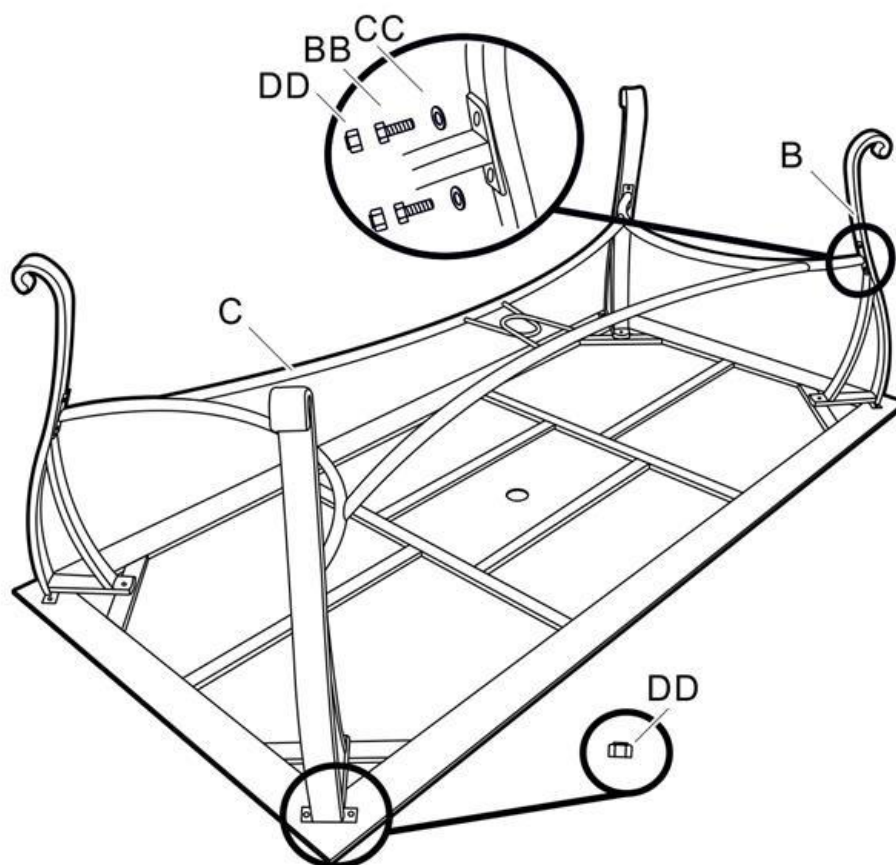
- Remove the plastic clamps from the table rim (A), and remove the ceramic tile top (D) from the table rim (A), and carefully place the ceramic top (D) & (E) on a soft surface.
- Carefully place the table top upside down on a soft, flat and non-abrasive surface.
- Attach the leg (B) to the table rim (A) using hex bolt (AA) & (BB) and washers (CC).



Assembly Instruction (continued)

2 Attaching the connector ring

- Attach the connector ring (C) to the leg (B) using hex bolts (BB) and washers (CC).
- Ensure all bolts are aligned and assembled correctly
- Tighten all hex bolts (AA) and (BB) with the hex wrench (EE). Attach the hex bolt caps (DD)

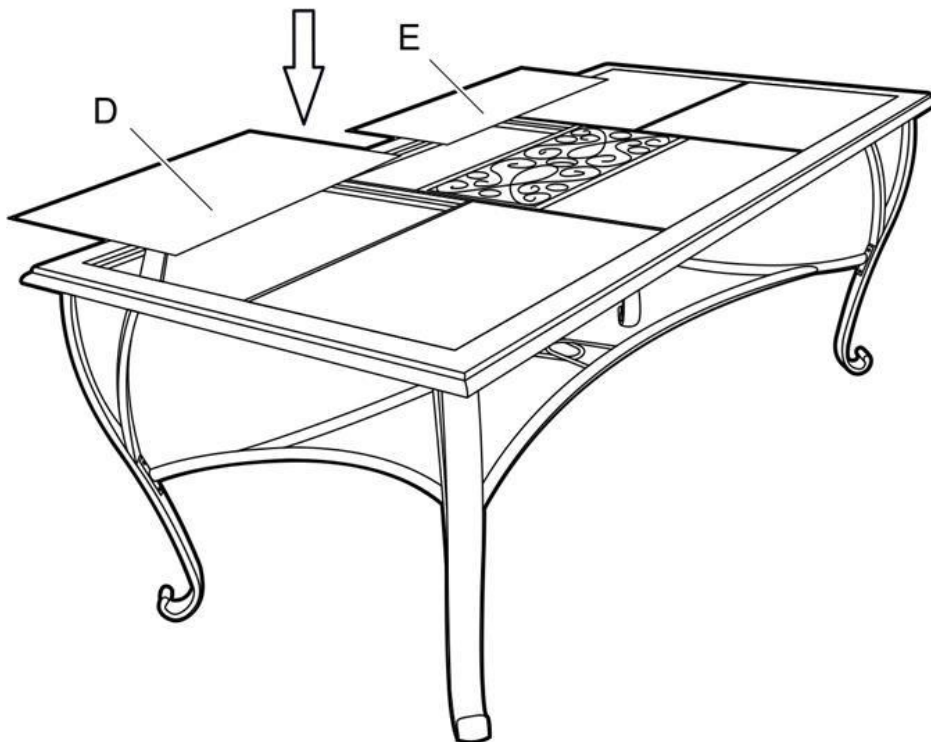
3 Replacing the ceramic tile top

WARNING:



1. Do not crawl, stand, or sit on tile table tops.
2. Do not set or lay heavy items on tile table tops.
3. Avoid extreme hot & cold items being placed on tile table tops.

- With the assistance of another person carefully turn the table over and set it down on its legs.
- Place the Ceramic tile top (D) and (E) onto the table.
- The dining table is ready for your enjoyment.

1 Attaching the arms

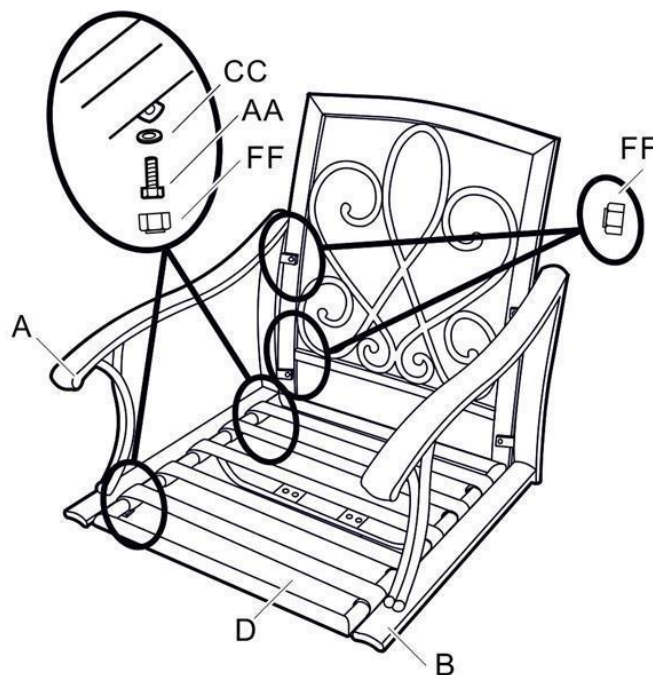
- Attach the right arm (A) to the back (C) using M6 hex bolts (AA) and M6 washers (CC).
- Repeat these instructions to attach the left arm (B) to the back frame (C).

2 Attaching the seat

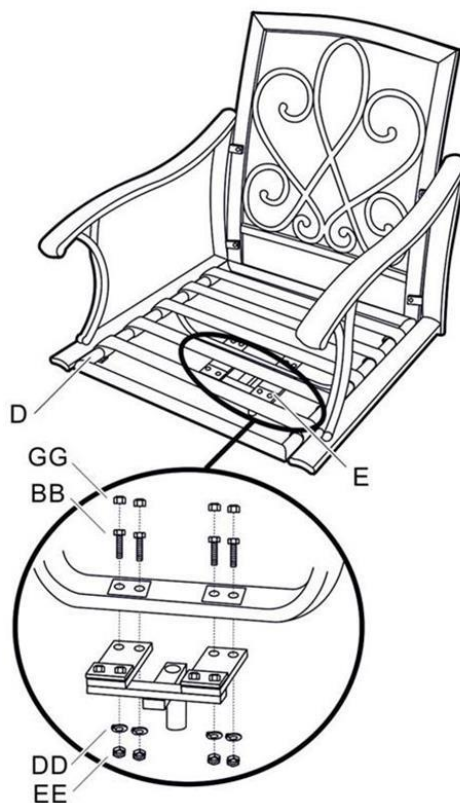
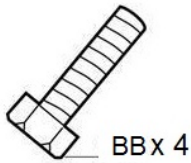
- Attach the seat frame (D) to the right arm (A) using M6 hex bolts (AA) and M6 washers (CC).
- Repeat these instructions to attach the seat frame (D) to the left arm (B).
- Tighten all the M6 hex bolts (AA) with the hex wrench (HH). Attach the M6 bolts caps (FF).



Assembly Instruction (continued)

3 Attaching the T-Rocker

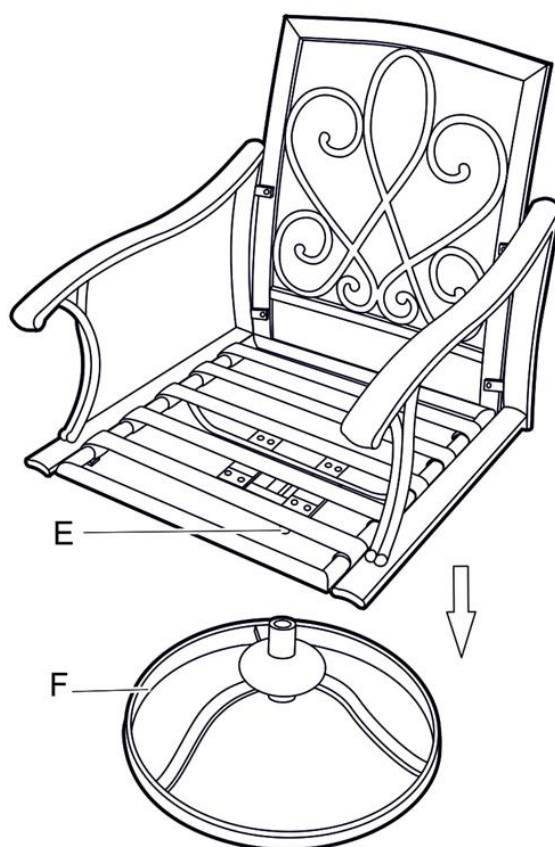
- Attach the T-Rocker (D) to the seat (D) using M8 hex bolts (BB), M8 washers (DD) and M8 nuts (EE).
- Tighten all the M8 hex bolts (BB) and M8 nut (EE) with the hex wrench (HH). Attach the M8 bolt caps (GG).



Assembly Instruction (continued)

4 Inserting the T-Rocker

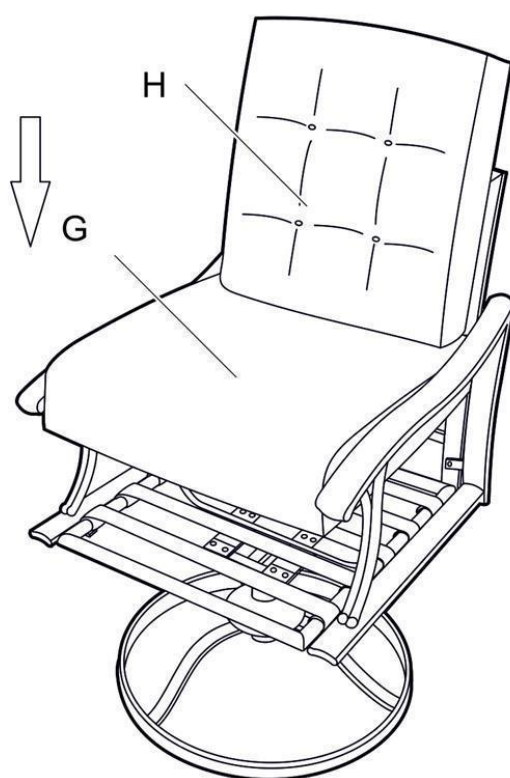
- Insert the T-Rocker (E) into the base (F). Make sure the seat bottoms out in the base for safety.



Assembly Instruction (continued)

5 Adding the cushions

- Place the seat cushion (G), back cushion (H) onto the swivel rocker.
- Repeat these instructions to assembly the other swivel rocker.
- The swivel rockers are ready for enjoyment.

1 Adding the arms

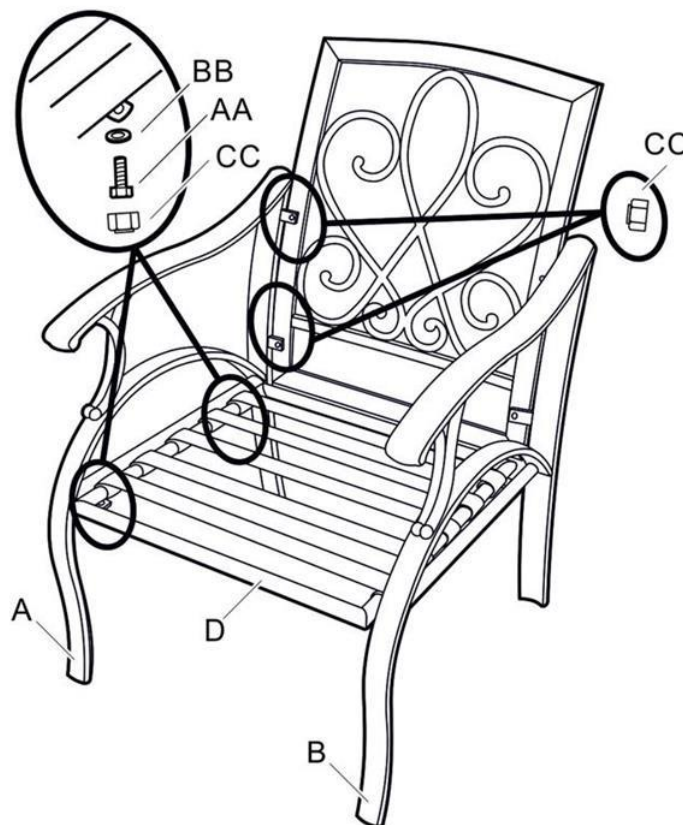
- Attach the right arm (A) to the back frame (C) using M6 hex bolts (AA) and M6 washers (BB).
- Repeat these instructions to attach the left arm (B) to the back frame (C).

2 Attaching the seat

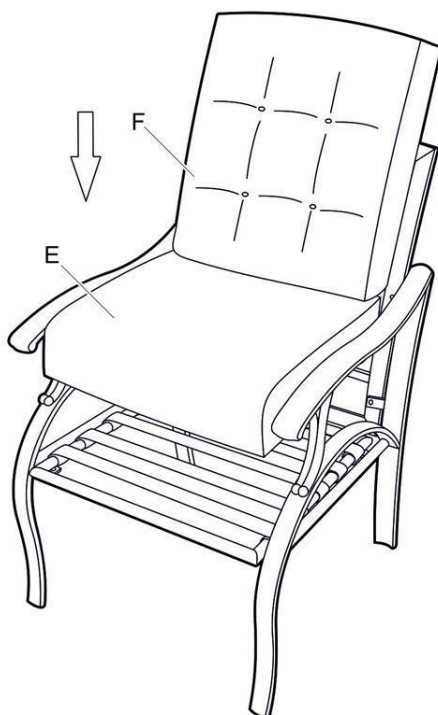
- Attach the seat (D) to the right arm (A) using M6 hex bolts (AA) and M6 washers (BB).
- Repeat these instructions to attach the left arm (B) to the seat frame (D).
- Ensure all bolts aligned and assembled correctly.
- Tighten all the M6 hex bolts (AA) with the hex wrench (DD). Attach the hex bolts caps (CC).



Assembly Instruction (continued)

3 Adding the cushions

- Place the seat cushion (E), back cushion (F) onto stationary dining chair.
- Repeat these instructions to assembly the other three stationary dining chairs.
- The dining chairs are ready for enjoyment.





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
