


Attaching the right arm



NOTE: Do not fully tighten the bolts.


Attach the seat frame (C) to the right arm (A) by using M6 hex bolts (AA) and M6 washers (CC).






3 Attaching the left arm

- □ Attach the left arm (B) to the seat frame (C) by using M6 hex bolts (AA) and M6 washers (CC).
- Tighten all M6 hex bolts (AA) & (BB) with the hex wrench (EE). Attach the M6 plastic caps (DD).



4 Adding the cushions

- □ With the assistance of another person turn the chair to an upright position.
- □ Place the seat cushion (E), back cushion (F) and lumbar pillow (G) onto the lounge chair.
- □ Repeat these instructions to assemble another lounge chair.
- □ Lounge chairs are ready for your enjoyment.





NOTE: Do not fully tighten the bolts.


Attach the seat frame (C) to the right arm (A) by using M6 hex bolts (AA) and M6 washers (CC).





3 Attaching the left arm


- □ Attach the left arm (B) to the back frame (D) by using M6 hex bolts (BB) and M6 washers (CC).

4 Attaching the middle leg to back


Attach the middle legs (E) to the back frame (D) by using M6 hex bolts (AA) and M6 washers (CC).






5 Attaching the middle leg to seat

- Tighten all M6 hex bolts (AA) & (BB) with the hex wrench (EE). Attach the M6 plastic caps (DD).



6 Adding the cushions

- □ With the assistance of another person turn the chair to an upright position.
- □ Place the seat cushion (F), back cushion (G) and lumbar pillow (H) onto the sofa.
- □ Sofa is ready for your enjoyment.







Attaching the connector

- □ Attach the leg connector (B) to the leg (A) using M6 hex bolts (AA) and M6 washers (BB).






2 Attaching the table rim

- □ Attach the leg (A) to the table rim (C) by using M6 hex bolts (AA) and M6 washers (BB).
- □ Ensure all bolts are aligned and assembled correctly.
- □ Tighten all M6 hex bolts (AA) with the hex wrench (DD). Attach the M6 plastic caps (CC).





Replacing the ceramic tile top


- □ With the assistance of another person, carefully turn the table over and set it down on its legs.
- □ Place the ceramic tile top (D) onto the table.
- □ The coffee table is ready for your enjoyment.
