EXAMINE YOUR FURNITURE

 Examine occasionally to ensure that there are no loose parts. If loose parts are found, they must be retightened fully before additional use.

Do not set or lay heavy items on table tops.
Avoid extreme hot & cold items being placed on table tops.

2 YEARS WARRANTY FOR FRAME, 1 YEAR WARRANTY FOR CUSHIONS

WHAT IS COVERED

We warrant the frame to be free of manufacturing defects to the original purchaser for 2 years.

WHAT IS NOT COVERED

It remains the customer's responsibility for freight and packaging charges to and from our service center.

This warranty does not cover commercial use, hardware, acts of nature, fire, freezing and abusive use.

Discoloration or fading of the finish or fabrics as a result of chemicals or spills is not covered.

Glass table top breakage and corrosion or rusting of hardware are not covered.

In addition, purchase parts are not covered under this warranty.

Warranty (continued)

Proof of purchase (dated register receipt) is required for warranty claims.

We reserve the right to make substitutions with similar merchandise, if the model in question is no longer in production.

Care and Maintenance

- Do not allow water to build up in frames. This will cause corrosion and possible freezing damage in cold climates.
- Use a mild soap and water for normal cleaning. DO NOT use janitorial or alcohol based cleaners. Some cleaners may be marked as natural, but some ingredients can cause discoloration or have adverse reaction to your finish.
- □ Rinse with clean water and dry with a soft, absorbent cloth towel.
- Cushions, slings, and/or an umbrella may be cleaned by hand with a solution of soap and water with a clean water rinse. Never machine wash as this will result in shrinking or damage. After cleaning, tip on end and allow to drip dry. Never use a commercial or home dryer to tumble dry fabric goods.
- Treat frames with liquid wax for maximum protection against UV rays and /or salty, damp air.
- Umbrella should be closed when not in use. Umbrella should be removed and stored in the event of wind, rain, hail, sleet, snow, or any other inclement weather. To prevent damage to your table, always use an umbrella base with your umbrella. Store indoors during winter months.
- Use and operation: To prolong the life of your outdoor furniture, cover when not in use. Store indoors during winter months.

PLANNING ASSEMBLY

PLEASE READ COMPLETE USE AND CARE GUIDE PRIOR TO ASSEMBLY!

Identify all parts packed in the carton against the parts list. Remove all protective materials and place the parts on a nonabrasive surface to avoid scratching. It takes about 45 minutes for 3 persons to complete all the assembly.


- □ EVERY BOLT NEEDS TO BE USED WITH A WASHER.

Lounge Chair Assembly Instruction

Attaching the arm


- □ Attach the right arm (D) to the seat (E) using M6 hex bolts (CC) and M6 washers (FF).
- □ Repeat these instructions to attach the left arm (C) to the seat (E).
- Do not tighten the hex bolts until assembly is complete.





2 Attaching the back


- □ Attach the back (F) to the left arm (C) using M6 hex bolts (CC) and M6 washers (FF).
- \Box Repeat these instructions to attach the back (E) to the right arm (D).
- $\hfill\square$ Ensure all bolts are aligned and assembled correctly.
- □ Tighten all M6 hex bolts (CC) with the socket wrench. Attach the M6 hex bolt caps (GG).



Lounge Chair Assembly Instruction (continued)

$\mathbf{3}$ Adding the cushions


- □ Place the seat cushion (G), back cushion (H) and toss pillow (I) onto the lounge chair.
- □ Repeat these instructions to assemble another lounge chair.
- □ Lounge chairs are ready for your enjoyment.



Sofa Assembly Instruction

Attaching the arm


- □ Attach the right arm (D) to the seat (J) using M6 hex bolts (AA) and M6 washers (FF).
- □ Repeat these instructions to attach the left arm (C) to the seat (J).
- Do not tighten the hex bolts until assembly is complete.



Sofa Assembly Instruction (continued)

2 Attaching the back


- □ Attach the back (K) to the right arm (D) using M6 hex bolts (BB) and M6 washers (FF).
- □ Repeat these instructions to attach the back (K) to the left arm (C).
- □ Attach the back (K) to the seat (J) using M6 hex bolts (DD) and M6 washer (FF).
- □ Ensure all bolts are aligned and assembled correctly.
- □ Tighten all hex bolts (AA), (BB) and (DD) with socket wrench. Attach the hex bolt caps (GG).



Sofa Assembly Instruction (continued)


$\mathbf{3}$ Adding the cushions


- □ Place the seat cushion (G), the back cushion (H) and toss pillow (I) onto the sofa.
- $\hfill\square$ The sofa is now ready for use.



Attaching the table leg

- □ Carefully place the table top (A) upside down on a soft, flat and non-abrasive surface.
- □ Attach the leg (B) to the table top (A) using M6 hex bolt (EE) and M6 washers (FF).
- □ Ensure all bolts are aligned and assembled correctly.
- □ Tighten all hex bolts (EE) with socket wrench. Attach the hex bolt caps (GG).





2 Positioning the table


WARNING:



Do not crawl, stand, or sit on table tops.

3. Avoid extreme hot &cold items being placed on table tops.

- With the assistance of another person carefully turn the table over and set it down on its legs.
