
**1.** Insert Post (B) through Base Cap (E) into base Flange (D), and use Bolt (AA) to secure. Repeat this step for Post (A, C).



**2.** Insert Long Crossbar (F) into Center Connector (L) then connect wires in same color. Insert Long Crossbar (G) into Center Connector (L) then secure by Bolts (AA). Don't tighten bolts before complete this step assembly.




**3.** Insert Short Crossbar (J) into Center Connector (L) then connect wires in same color. Insert Short Crossbar (K) into Center Connector (L) then secure by Bolts (AA). Don't tighten bolts before complete this step assembly.




4. Insert Long Crossbar (H) into Center Connector (L).


Insert Long Crossbar (I) into Center Connector (L) then secure by Bolts (AA). Don't tighten bolts before complete this step assembly.




**5.** Insert wires on the two side of short crossbar into post A and C. Use Bolts (BB) secure Post (A, C) on the two side of Short Crossbar (J, K). Please check below fig. and make sure short crossbar in right direction. Don't tighten bolts before complete this step assembly.




**6.** Insert wires on the two side of short crossbar into post B and C. Use Bolts (BB) secure Post (B, C) on the two side of Short Crossbar (J, K). Please check below fig. and make sure short crossbar in right direction. Don't tighten bolts before complete this step assembly.




7. Insert wires on the two side of long crossbar into post A and B. Use Bolts (BB) secure Post (A, B, C) on the two side of Long Crossbar (F, G, I, J). Please check below fig. and make sure short crossbar in right direction. Don't tighten bolts before complete this step assembly.







**8.** Use Bolts (AA) secure Fixed Plate (M) on the top of each post and crossbar. Then connect same color of wires together.




9. Connect AC Adapter and turn on the switch.




10. Place Post Upper Cap (N) on the top of each Post (A, B, C).







11. Insert 2-tier Roof Tube (P) into Roof Tube (Q). Repeat this step for remaining tubes.




**12.** Insert 2-tier Roof Tube (P) into Roof Connector (O). Place Roof Tube (Q) on the top corner of post, the secure by Bolts (CC) with Bolt nuts (DD).Repeat this step for the remaining 2-tier Roof Tube and Roof Tube.




**13.** Insert Air Vent Tube (S) into 2-tier Center Connector (R), secure Air Vent Tube (S) onto 2-tier Roof Tube (P) using Bolts (AA).




**14.** Insert Long Roof Tube (T) into Roof Connector (O) then secure Long Roof Tube (T) by Bolts (CC) with Bolt nuts (DD). Insert Short Roof Tube (U) into Roof Connector (O) then secure Short Roof Tube (U) by Screws (CC) with Nut (DD).



**15.** Place Canopy (X) and Air Vent Cover (Y) on the top then secure Finial (V) on the top of Canopy. Place Canopy in right position of each corner and hang Netting (W). Insert Stake (Z) through Base Flange (E) into ground.




**16.** Connect AC Adapter and turn on the switch.




**17.** Connect AC adapter and turn on the switch (located on the top of Post A). Turn on the audio controller switch (located on the bottom of post in black round bottom).

There are 3 ways to play the music:

- 1. Wireless (see figure 1)
- 2. MicroSD (see figure 2)
- 3. AUX (see figure 3)






AUX:

 Turn on unit by pushing the black ON/OFF Button. The Red LED light will blink (until you connect your device).
 Use connect wire (AC) to connect your output device, the Red LED light will turn solid Blue light.

3. When your play music the Blue LED light will keep solid.




Bluetooth:

1. Turn on unit by pushing the black ON/OFF Button. The Red LED light will blink (until you connect your wireless device).

2. On your device, turn Bluetooth on. Set your device to search "GAZEBO", select "GAZEBO" to pair your device, the Red LED light will turn solid once you are connected.

3. When you play music the Red LED light will continue to blink.




MicroSD:

 Turn on unit by pushing the black ON/OFF/ Button.
 The Red LED light will blink (until you insert your MicroSD)
 Insert MicroSD, the Red LED light will turn solid Blue light.

3. When you play music the Blue LED light will continue to blink.




1. Take out Canopy (X) from corner. Disconnect all the wires. Warning: Please make sure the power is disconnect.

2. Turn counterclockwise to release and take out the LED lights. Place new LED lights then tighten up in clockwise.







## Instruction of Replace LED Lights

3. Connect all same color wires together then place back the canopy.




## Instruction of Replace Speakers


2. Connect all wires with new speaker, secure speaker on the post. Place back speaker cover. Warning: This speaker is special design for this product only. Do not replace or modify this product.

1. Take off audio controller cover then release screws. Take out audio controller box slowly then disconnect wires.



#### **Solutions to Common Speaker**

Phenomenon Problems	Solutions
Several unsuccessful connection attempts	<ol> <li>Ensure the speakers is in standby mode and turn off connection with all Bluetooth devices.</li> <li>Or restart.</li> </ol>
Volume too low or sound distorted	<ol> <li>Or reboot change to Turn off the power for 10 seconds.</li> <li>Or restart.</li> </ol>
Discontinuous sound for music playing	Move the speaker closer or remove obstacles between speaker and your music playing device. Make sure the distance in between umbrella and device within 10m.
Indicator light not work	<ol> <li>Check power supply voltage.</li> <li>Or restart.</li> </ol>
