


Power

AC power: requires AC power cable (included).




Battery Power

Requires 6 C-size, batteries (not included).



CD/Line In, Off, FM, **AM**

Adjust to switch between CD/Line In, Off, FM, or AM modes.



Stop


Press to stop a CD during play.

Program

Press to program the loaded CD to play tracks in a specified order.

Repeat

Press to repeat the current track. Press twice to repeat the entire album.



Skip/Search

Press to skip between tracks on a loaded CD.

Press and hold to search through the current track.

Press to play or pause a loaded CD.

Loading a CD

- 1. Open the CD Door.
- 2. Place a CD into the boombox, label side facing up.
- 3. Close the CD Door.

Playing a CD

- 1. Follow the instructions for Loading a CD.
- Adjust the CD/Line In, Off, FM, AM switch to CD.
- 3. Press the **Play/Pause** button to begin playing the loaded CD.

Programming a CD

- Follow the instructions for <u>Loading a CD</u> and <u>Playing a CD</u>.
- Press the **Stop** button to stop the CD during play.
- 3. Press the Program button.

"01" will begin to blink on the display.

- 4. Press the **Skip/Search** buttons to select a track.
- 5. Press the **Program** button to save the selected track to the program.
- Repeat steps 4 and 5 to program up to 20 tracks.

Radio

Playing the Radio

- Adjust the CD/Line In, Off, FM, AM switch to AM or FM radio mode.
- 2. Adjust the **Tuning** dial to tune the radio.

Radio Reception

Adjust the position of the **Telescopic FM Antenna** to improve FM radio reception.

An AM antenna is built into the clock radio. To improve AM radio reception, adjust the position of the clock radio.

3.5 mm Audio input

Using the Audio Input

Requires a 3.5mm audio cable (not included).

- Connect a 3.5mm audio cable to the 3.5mm Audio Input and the audio output on an MP3 player or other audio device.
- Adjust the CD/Line In, Off, FM, AM switch to CD/line In mode.
- 3. Use the native controls on the connected MP3 player or other audio source to play your audio through the boombox.

When not in use, make sure to disconnect the 3.5mm audio cable (not included).
