<ul> <li>Warnings</li> <li>Reye's syndrome: Children and teenagers who have or are recovering from chicken pox or flu-like symptoms should not use this product. When using this product, if changes in behavior with nausea and vomiting occur, consult a doctor because these symptoms could be an early sign of Reye's syndrome, a rare but serious illness.</li> <li>Allergy alert: Aspirin may cause a severe allergic reaction which may include:</li> <li>hives • facial swelling • asthma (wheezing) • shock</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Stomach bleeding warning: This product contains an NSAID, which may cause severe stomach bleeding. The chance is higher if you</li> <li>are age 60 or older</li> <li>have had stomach ulcers or bleeding problems</li> <li>take a blood thinning (anticoagulant) or steroid drug</li> <li>take a blood thinning (conticoagulant) or steroid drug</li> <li>take other drugs containing prescription or nonprescription NSAIDs (aspirin, ibuprofen, naproxen, or others)</li> <li>have 3 or more alcoholic drinks every day while using this product</li> <li>take more or for a longer time than directed</li> <li>Sore throat warning: If sore throat is severe, persists for more than 2 days, is accompanied or followed by fever, headache, rash, nausea, or vomiting, consult a doctor promptly.</li> <li>Do not use to sedate children.</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Do not use</li> <li>if you are allergic to aspirin or any other pain reliever/fever reducer</li> <li>if you are now taking a prescription monoamine oxidase inhibitor (MAOI) (certain drugs for depression, psychiatric, or emotional conditions, or Parkinson's disease), or for 2 weeks after stopping the MAOI drug. If you do not know if your prescription drug contains an MAOI, ask a doctor or pharmacist before taking this product.</li> <li>if you have ever had an allergic reaction to this product or any of its ingredients</li> <li>in children under 12 years of age</li> </ul>
Ask a doctor before use if         • stomach bleeding warning applies to you         • you have a history of stomach problems, such as heartburn         • you have high blood pressure, heart disease, liver cirrhosis, or kidney disease         • you are taking a diuretic         • you have         • asthma       • diabetes         • thyroid disease       • glaucoma         • difficulty in urination due to enlargement of the prostate gland         • a breathing problem such as emphysema or chronic bronchitis

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<ul> <li>When using this product</li> <li>do not exceed recommended dosage</li> <li>excitability may occur, especially in children</li> <li>you may get drowsy</li> <li>avoid alcoholic drinks</li> <li>alcohol, sedatives, and tranquilizers may increase drowsiness</li> <li>be careful when driving a motor vehicle or operating machinery</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Stop use and ask a doctor if</li> <li>an allergic reaction occurs. Seek medical help right away.</li> <li>you experience any of the following signs of stomach bleeding <ul> <li>feel faint</li> <li>vomit blood</li> <li>have bloody or black stools</li> <li>have stomach pain that does not get better</li> </ul> </li> <li>pain or nasal congestion gets worse or lasts more than 7 days</li> <li>fever gets worse or lasts more than 3 days</li> <li>redness or swelling is present</li> <li>new symptoms occur</li> <li>ringing in the ears or a loss of hearing occurs</li> <li>nervousness, dizziness, or sleeplessness occurs</li> </ul>
If pregnant or breast-feeding, ask a health professional before use. It is especially important not to use aspirin during the last 3 months of pregnancy unless definitely directed to do so by a doctor because it may cause problems in the unborn child or complications during delivery. Keep out of reach of children. In case of overdose, get medical help or contact a Poison Control Center right away.
<ul> <li>Directions</li> <li>adults and children 12 years and over: take 2 tablets fully dissolved in 4 oz of water every 4 hours. Do not exceed 8 tablets in 24 hours or as directed by a doctor.</li> <li>children under 12 years: do not use</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Other information</li> <li>each tablet contains: sodium 476 mg</li> <li>Phenylketonurics: Contains Phenylalanine 8.4 mg Per Tablet</li> <li>store at room temperature. Avoid excessive heat.</li> </ul>
<b>Inactive ingredients</b> acesulfame potassium, anhydrous citric acid, aspartame, calcium silicate, dimethicone, docusate sodium, flavors, mannitol, povidone, sodium benzoate, sodium bicarbonate
