

Limited Warranty

Airbox™ Digital Receiver and Airbox HD DVR Limited Warranty

One Year Parts and Labor

Who is covered?

You must have proof of purchase to receive warranty service. A sales receipt or other document showing that you purchased the Airbox™ Digital Receiver or Airbox HD DVR (the “Receiver”) is considered proof of purchase. This limited warranty extends only to the original consumer purchaser or any person receiving the Equipment as a gift from the original consumer purchaser and to no other purchaser or transferee. This warranty does not extend to commercial users. The term “Equipment” means the Receiver and the cables, power supply, and remote control that are included with the Receiver in the original packaging.

What Does This Warranty Cover?

Airbox Television Inc. (“Airbox”) warrants that the Equipment will be free from defects in materials and workmanship during the limited warranty period described herein. The limited warranty coverage begins the day you purchase the Equipment as further described in the following text. For one year from the purchase date, the Equipment will be replaced with a repaired, renewed or comparable product (whichever is deemed necessary by Airbox) if it becomes defective or inoperative; this exchange is done without charge to you for parts and labor (except applicable taxes, if any). The limited warranty only covers defects in the Equipment you have purchased and does not guarantee you will be able to receive the Airbox signal. Receipt of the Airbox signal requires that the Equipment be properly used in our coverage area and any such use outside our coverage area voids this warranty. Our coverage area may change from time to time.

All Equipment, including replacement products, is covered only for the original warranty period. When the warranty on the original Equipment expires, the warranty on the replacement product also expires. After one year from the date of purchase, you pay for the replacement of all parts, and for all labor and shipping charges.

How Long Does The Coverage Last?

This warranty lasts for one (1) year for parts and labor from the date of purchase (“Warranty Period”). SOME STATES DO NOT ALLOW LIMITATIONS ON HOW LONG AN IMPLIED WARRANTY LASTS, SO THIS LIMITATION MAY NOT APPLY TO YOU. Coverage terminates if you sell or otherwise transfer the Equipment.

What Will AIRBOX Do?

AIRBOX warrants the Equipment against defects in materials and workmanship during the Warranty Period.

If a defect is discovered in the Equipment and a valid claim is received by AIRBOX or an Authorized Airbox Retailer within the Warranty Period, AIRBOX or an Authorized Airbox Retailer will provide you a replacement device.

AIRBOX warrants replacement equipment or parts provided under this warranty against defects in materials and workmanship for the remaining portion of the original Equipment's Warranty Period. When the Equipment or part is exchanged, any replacement item becomes your property and the replaced item becomes AIRBOX's property.

This Warranty Does Not Cover:

- damage caused by accident, abuse, misuse, or act of God (such as a flood, lightning, power fluctuation or fire);
- damage caused by service or repair performed by anyone other than AIRBOX or its designee;
- damage to Equipment or a part that has been modified (including without limitation software modification) without the express written permission of AIRBOX;
- damage to Equipment if its serial number has been removed or defaced;
- damage to Equipment or property other than the Equipment even if caused by the Equipment defect;
- damage to Equipment in the event that it is opened or otherwise tampered without AIRBOX's express permission;
- any Equipment used for commercial or institutional purposes;
- reception transmission problems caused by signal conditions or antenna systems outside the unit;
- labor charges for installation or set-up of the Equipment;
- installation, performance, or repair of any antenna, audio/video cabling or accessory attachments used with the Equipment; or
- continued provisioning of any of the programming and other services delivered through the Equipment including but not limited to television programming, show information, program guide data, recording services, and scheduling information.

TO THE MAXIMUM EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW, THIS WARRANTY AND THE REMEDIES SET FORTH ABOVE ARE EXCLUSIVE AND IN LIEU OF ALL OTHER WARRANTIES, REMEDIES AND CONDITIONS, WHETHER ORAL OR WRITTEN, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED. AIRBOX SPECIFICALLY DISCLAIMS ANY AND ALL IMPLIED WARRANTIES, INCLUDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY, FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE AND NON-INFRINGEMENT. IF AIRBOX CANNOT LAWFULLY DISCLAIM OR EXCLUDE IMPLIED WARRANTIES UNDER APPLICABLE LAW, THEN TO THE EXTENT POSSIBLE ANY CLAIMS UNDER SUCH IMPLIED WARRANTIES SHALL EXPIRE ON

EXPIRATION OF THE WARRANTY PERIOD. No AIRBOX retailer, agent, or employee is authorized to make any modification, extension, or addition to this warranty.

TO THE MAXIMUM EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW, AIRBOX IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR, AND PURCHASER RELEASES AIRBOX FROM, DIRECT, SPECIAL, INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES RESULTING FROM ANY BREACH OF WARRANTY OR CONDITION, OR RELATED IN ANY WAY TO THE EQUIPMENT, OR UNDER ANY OTHER LEGAL OR EQUITABLE THEORY. Some states do not allow the exclusion or limitation of incidental or consequential damages, so the above limitation or exclusion may not apply to you.

In order to be eligible for service under this warranty you MUST contact AIRBOX Customer Care at 1-877-924-7269. If it is determined that the Equipment or any individual parts need to be returned for repair or exchange, you will be given a return authorization number and instructions on how to return the defective Equipment or any individual parts.
