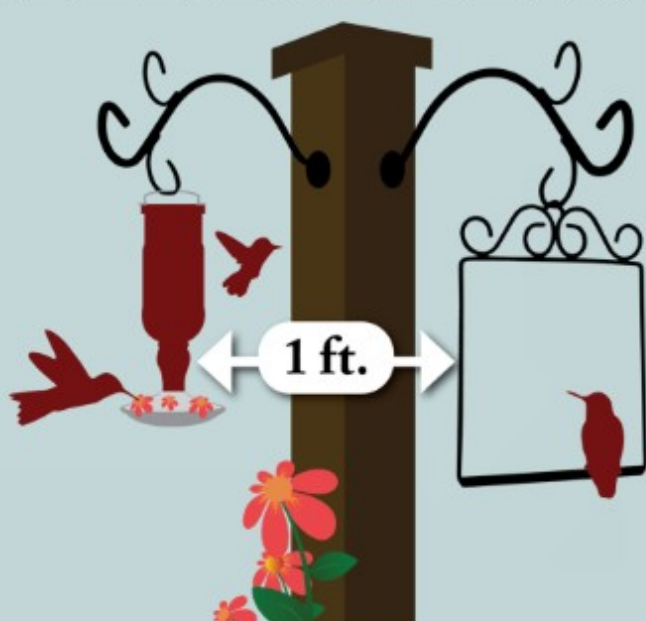
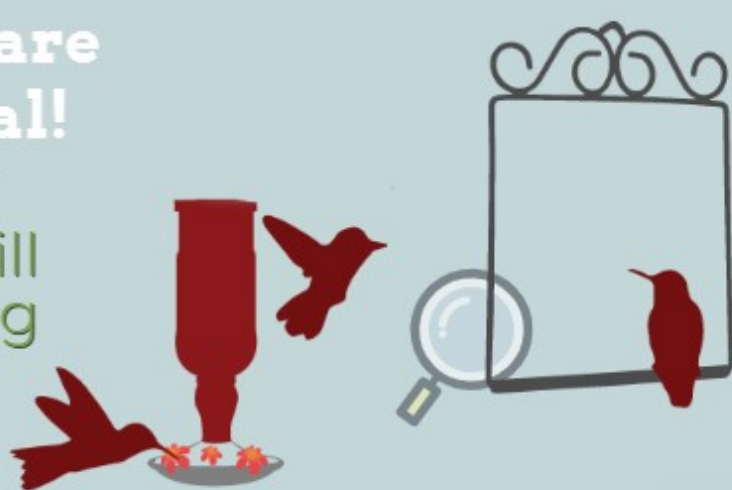


Do Hummingbirds really swing on it?

Yes! Hummingbirds are Extremely Territorial!

Just place next to a food source! Hummingbirds will use as a territorial perching spot to keep watch!



Create the IDEAL perching spot!

Hang swing 1 ft away from food source. Small screw hook included for hanging.



TIP

Switch with Feeder

Try placing the swing where an existing feeder was and moving the feeder a foot away. This will help hummingbirds find the swing due to their excellent recall memory.



Chose a Desirable Location for Your Swing

Hummingbirds are more likely to use the swing in a desirable location. Consider choosing an area out of direct sunlight and protected from the elements - such as hanging from over hanging eaves.

**Not recommended hanging in trees due to competing perching spots.*

Clean Feeder Regularly and Enjoy your Hummingbird Swing

Provide a reliable food source by changing nectar and cleaning every 1-2 days. May take hummingbirds an entire season to "discover" the swing. Especially if introduced mid-season, once a perching spot is already chosen.
