PLANNING ASSEMBLY

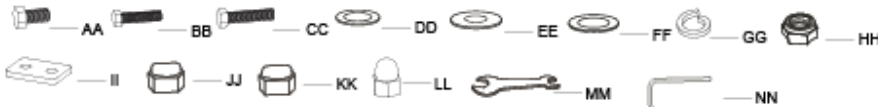

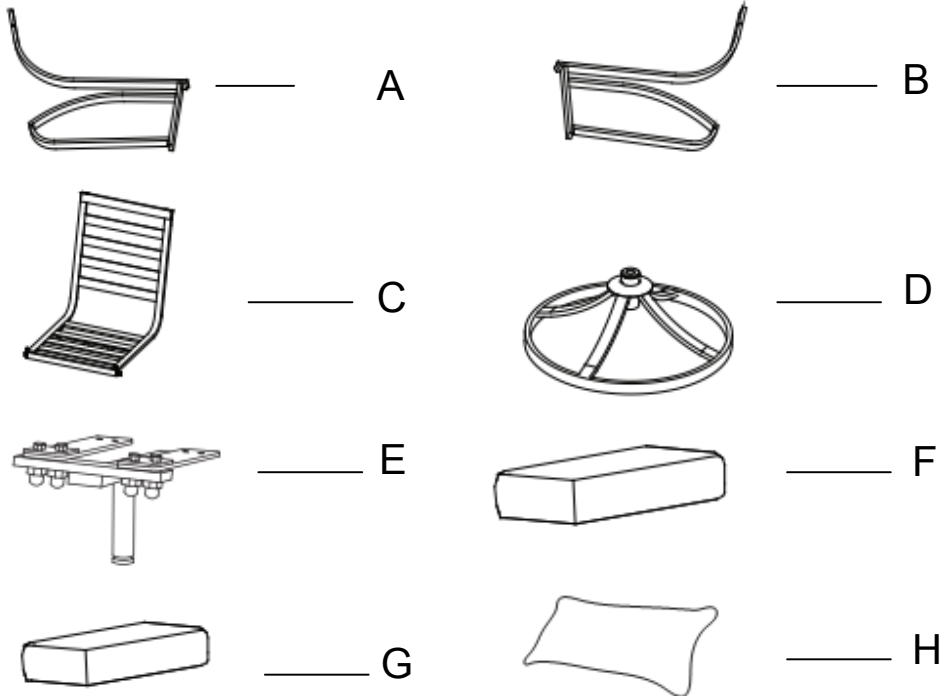

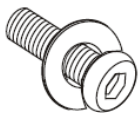

Assembly Instruction

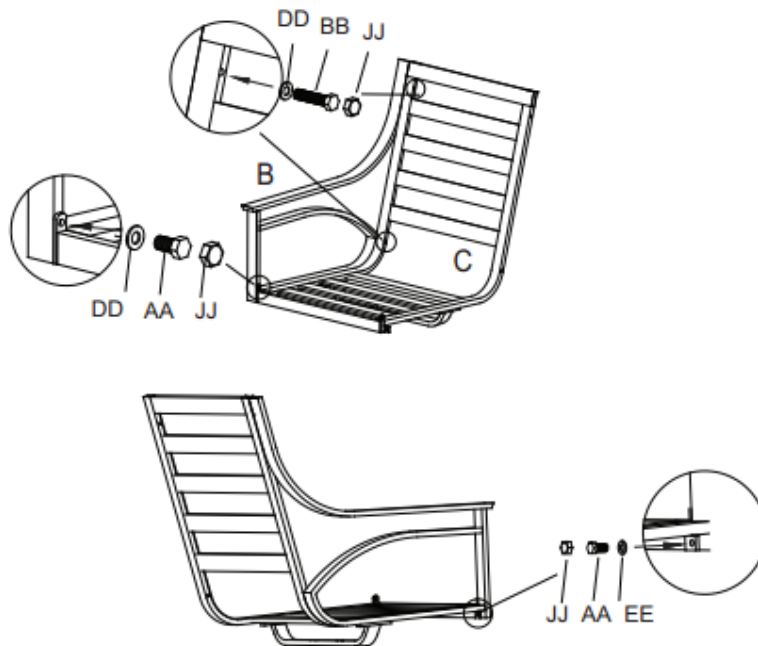
1 Attaching the right arm



NOTE: Do not fully tighten the bolts.

- Place the back/seat frame (C) on a sofa, flat non-abrasive surface.
- Attach the right arm (B) to the top and middle of the back/seat frame (C) with M6 allen/hex bolts (BB) and M6 small washers (DD).
- Attach the right arm (B) to the front of back/seat frame (C) with M6 hex bolts (AA), M6 small washer (DD) and M6 large washer (EE).

AA x 2 BB x 2 DD x 3 EE x 1



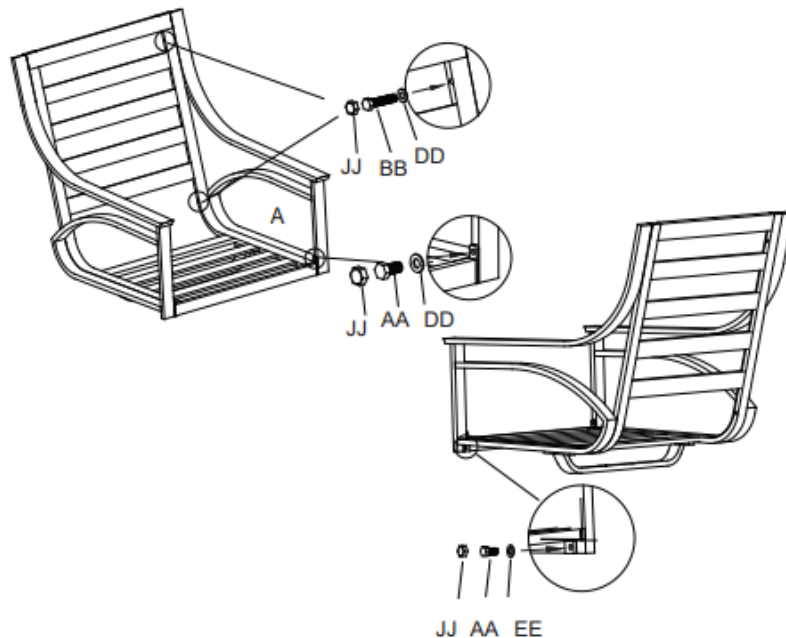
Assembly Instruction (continued)

2 Attaching the left arm



NOTE: Do not fully tighten the bolts.

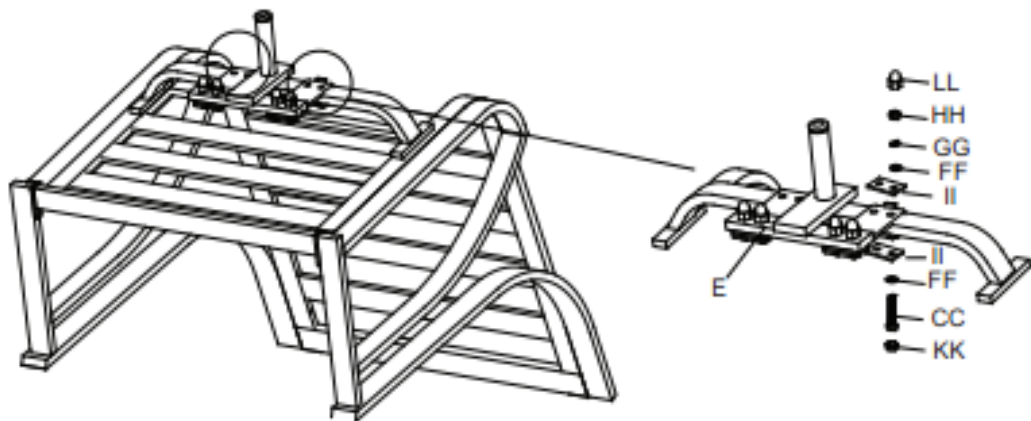
- Attach the left arm (A) to the top and middle of the back/seat frame (C) with M6 allen/hex bolts (BB) and M6 small washers (DD).
- Attach the left arm (A) to the front of back/seat frame (C) with M6 hex bolts (AA), M6 small washer (DD) and M6 large washer (EE).
- Ensure all bolts are aligned and assembled correctly.
- Tighten all M6 allen/ hex bolts (BB) with the allen wrench (NN) and the M6 hex bolts (AA) with the hex wrench (MM). Attach the M6 plastic caps (JJ).



Assembly Instruction (continued)

3 Attaching the T-Rocker

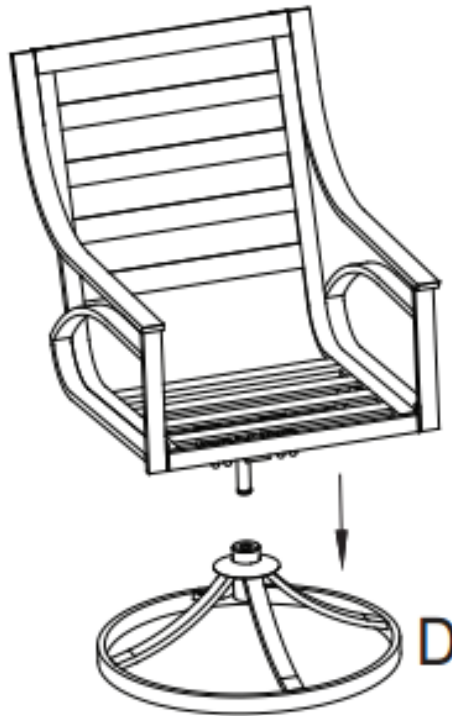
- Turn the chair bucket over and place the front side down.
- Attach the T-Rocker (E) to the U bar on the back/seat frame (C) using M8 hex bolts (CC), M8 washers (FF), steel plate (II), M8 lock washer (GG) and M8 nut (HH). The sequence should be M8 hex bolts (CC), M8 washer (FF), steel plate (II), back/seat frame (C), T-rocker (E), steel plate (II), M8 washer (FF), M8 lock washer (GG) and M8 nut (HH).
- Ensure all bolts are aligned and assembled correctly.
- Tighten all M8 bolts (CC) and M8 nuts (HH) with the hex wrench (MM). Attach the M8 plastic caps (KK) to M8 bolts (CC) and nut cap (LL) to M8 nut (HH).



Assembly Instruction (continued)

4 Inserting the T-Rocker

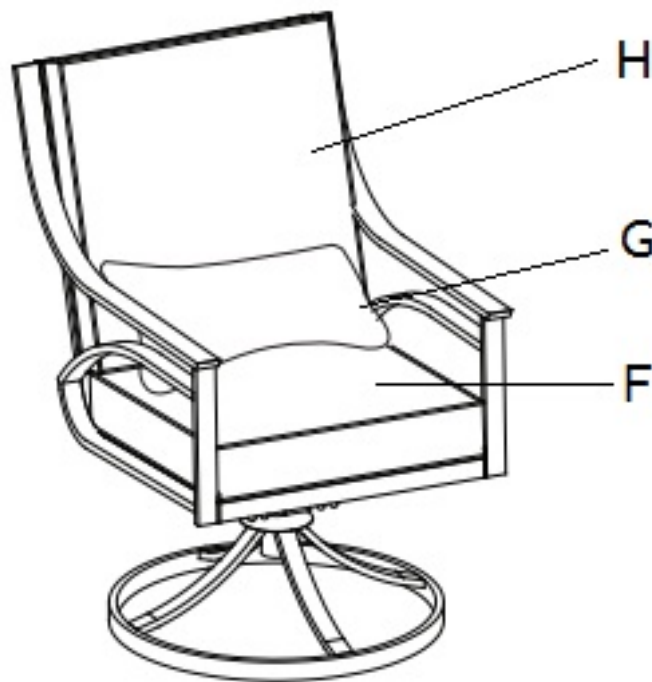
- Place the base (D) on a flat surface.
- With the assistance of another person carefully turn the seat bucket with the T-Rocker over.
- Align the chair seat with the center of the base (D).
- Insert the T-Rocker (E) into the base (D). Make sure the seat bottoms out in the base for safety.



Assembly Instruction (continued)

5 Placing the cushions

- Place the seat cushions (F), back cushions (G) and lumbar pillows (H) onto the rocker.
- Repeat these instructions to assemble the other three swivel rockers.
- The swivel rockers are ready for your enjoyment.

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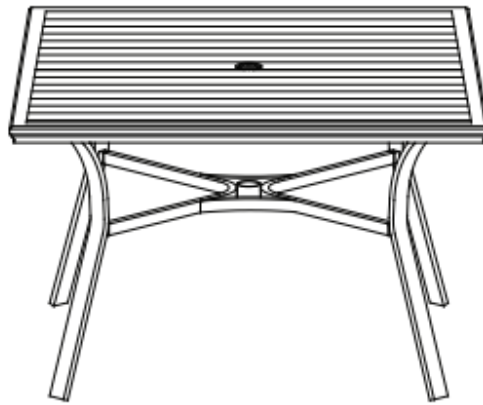

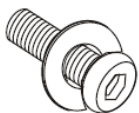

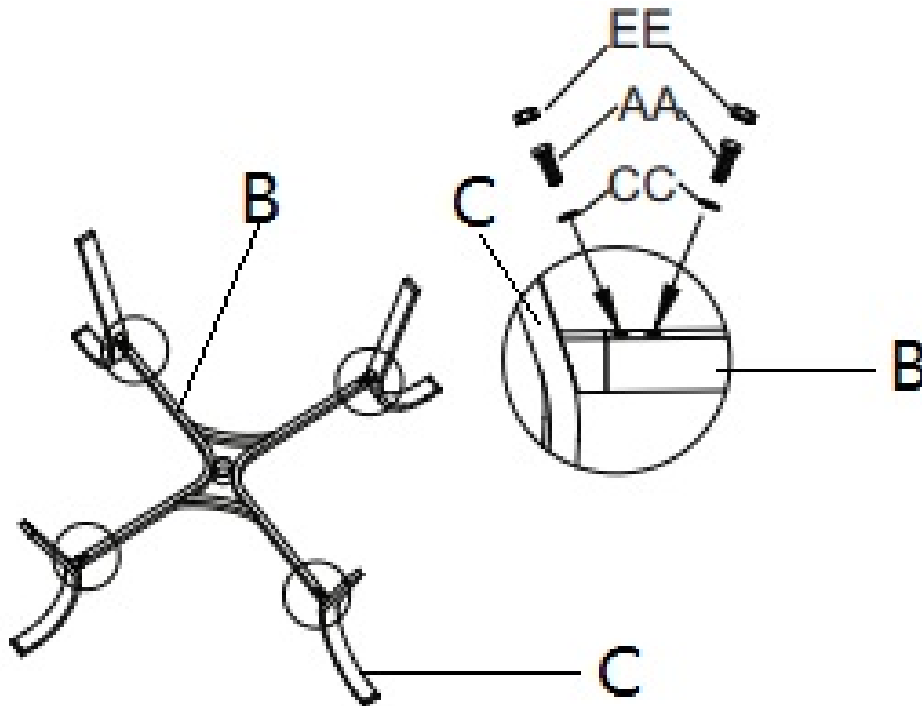
Assembly Instruction

1 Attaching the connector



NOTE: Do not fully tighten the bolts.

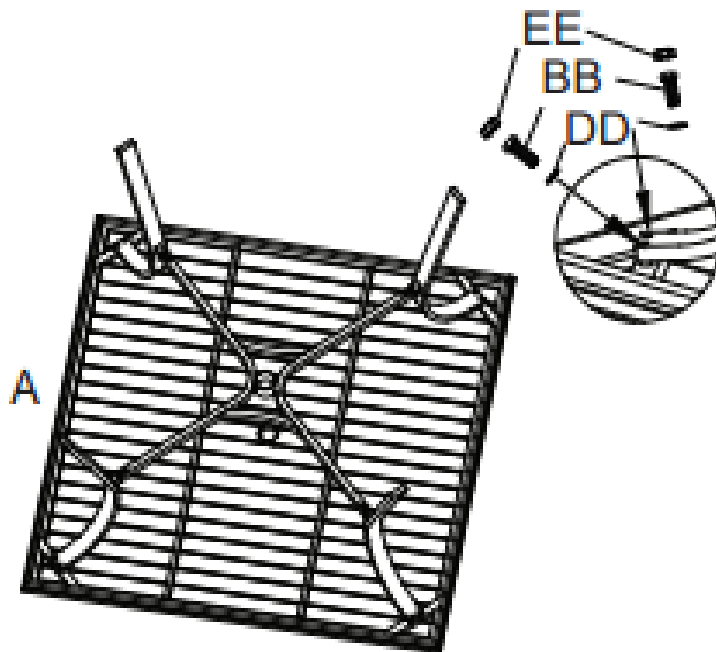
- Place the leg on a soft, flat non-abrasive surface.
- Attach the leg connector (B) to the leg (C) using M6 hex bolts (AA) and M6 small washers (CC).



Assembly Instruction (continued)

2 Attaching the table top

- Attach the leg (B) to the table top (A) by using M6 hex bolts (BB) and M6 large washers (DD).
- Ensure all bolts are aligned and assembled correctly.
- Tighten all M6 hex bolts (AA) & (BB) with the hex wrench (FF). Attach the M6 plastic caps (EE).

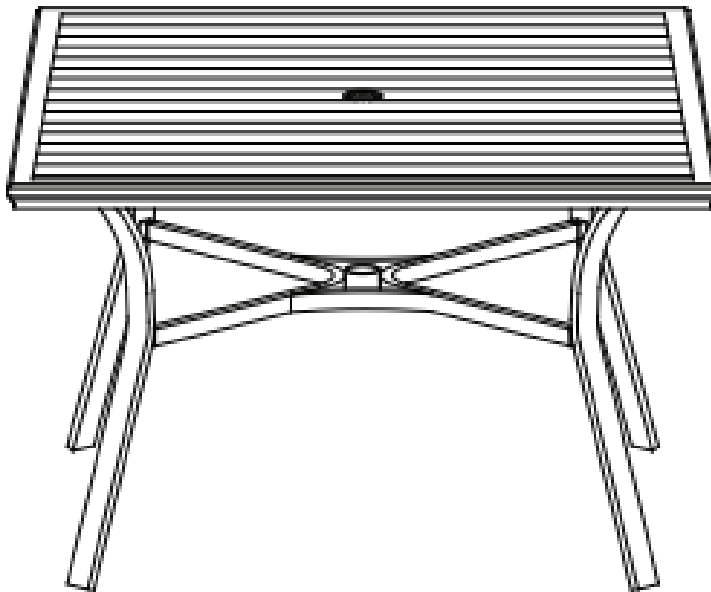
3 Positioning the table

- Carefully turn the table over and set it down on its legs.
- The dining table is ready for your enjoyment.
